PRAGUE, VIENNA & BUDAPEST

9 days/ 8 nights

Day 1. PRAGUE

Arrive in Prague. Meet and assist at the airport and transfer to hotel.

Overnight in Prague

Day 2. PRAGUE

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure for sightseeing tour of Prague. (ca. 3.5 hrs).

It introduces Prague as one of the most beautiful cities in Europe with its history and architecture over a thousand years.

We will visit the Old Town (Stare Mesto), the Republic Square (Namesti Republiky) one of the oldest towers of Prague called Powder Tower, the Municipal House (the highlight of Art Nouveau buildings in Prague), Wenceslas Square built by Charles IV and the famous Old Town Square (Old Town Square) surrounded by interesting streets.

In the square we will see the Church of Our Lady of Tyn, Church of St. Nicholas and the Old Town Hall. This building in the Old Town Square attracts more looks for their impressive Prague Astronomical Clock.

Before coming to the Charles Bridge we will see the Clementinum, the second largest city complex behind the Prague Castle.

Free time for lunch.

In the afternoon departure to participate in artistic tour of Prague including the Prague Castle with entrances fees to the Cathedral of St. Vitus.

Prague Castle is considered the largest medieval fortress in the world.

It has been a resident of the kings of Bohemia for many years.

Visit the Cathedral of San Vito the largest Gothic building in Prague, a monument built over six centuries and located in the castle complex.

We will see the Old Royal Palace created in the ninth century as a primitive wooden palace, the ancient palace underwent major changes to become the impressive building that remains today and the Basilica and Convent of San Jorge founded in 920, in today, it houses the collection of nineteenth century bohemian art of the Prague National Gallery.

Visit the so-called Golden Lane which is a short, narrow and beautiful street inside Prague Castle. It owes its name to the goldsmiths that lived in the seventeenth century. At house number 22 lived Franz Kafka, one of the most influential writers of the twentieth century, between 1916 and 1917.

Overnight in Prague

Day 3. PRAGUE

Breakfast at the hotel.

Departure on tour to the city of the hot springs, Karlovy Vary . (9 hrs apprx.)

The Karlovy Vary spa town with its healing waters.

Its history dates back to the fourteenth century, and its hot springs enjoyed such characters as the great German poet Goethe and Czar Peter I. of Russia.

The fame of Karlovy Vary also contributed making Moser glass, porcelain and herbal liquor Becherovka. You will discover with our guide the charming historic center the city with its typical colonnades and the famous geyser with a height of 17 meters.

Back to Prague in the afternoon.

Overnight in Prague.

Day 4. PRAGUE – VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast, we say goodbye to Prague and went by bus to Vienna.

We stop in the ancient coronation town of the Hungarian kings, Bratislava, now the capital of Slovakia.

We would make a city tour through the most important and significant places outside the old town and the presidential palace, the Danube promenade, the walls.

Bratislava Castle, Napoleon Hill and Slavin Monument where you stand will offer a wonderful view of the city; after the tour of the old town allows you to observe , the Istropolitan University, the S Martin Cathedral, the Primate's Palace - Archbishop, the Old Town Hall, and the Opera House, where ends visit.

Then continue to Vienna, capital of Austria.

Arrival. Check in.

Overnight in Vienna.

Day 5. VIENNA

Breakfast at the hotel

In the morning departure to sightseeing the Austrian capital. To see the Ringstrasse with its gardens, monuments and famous buildings: the State Opera, National Theatre, Parliament, Town Hall, Museum of Fine Arts Natural History, University Stock Exchange, Votive Church, academies of art, monuments to Mozart, Strauss, Goethe. During the tour we will visit inside Schoenbrunn Palace, the summer residence to rival Versailles and the famous people who lived as Maria Theresa, Franz Joseph and Sisi.

In the afternoon excursion to the Vienna Woods:

Excursion to the hunting lodge at Mayerling (site where Prince Rudolf committed suicide in 1889) in the monastery of Heiligenkreuz (Santa Cruz) .

we will visit the medieval cloister, Liechtenstein Castle (photo stop) and stop to see the lake Seegrotte (cave with the largest underground lake in Europe), car ride through the romantic valley of Elena, walk through the imperial city Baden built in Biedermeier style, where Mozart and Beethoven composed.

Return to Vienna.

Overnight in Vienna.

Day 6. VIENNA (Győr) – BUDAPEST

Breakfast at the hotel.

After breakfast, departure to Budapest.

During the trip we stop at the fourth largest city in Hungary, the city of three rivers, Győr which is the capital of the region of Kisalföld (Small Plain). The heart of the city is called Capitula Hill and here the main monuments, including the cathedral, of the eleventh century, are concentrated and modified with different styles.

Continue to the Hungarian capital. As we enter into the city, we have on the way the Gellert Hill with Citadel, a fortified enclosure built by the Austrians in 1850, one of the best vantage points from where you can take photos of the city (235 meters), as well in this way we understand how it is structured the city in the side of Buda and Pest. Mount Gellértrecibe its name from San Gerardo, a Christian bishop in the eleventh century came to Hungary at the invitation of King Stephen I to evangelize the Magyar tribes.

Arrival. Check in

Day 7. BUDAPEST

Breakfast at the hotel

Departure for sightseeing tour.

During the tour will visit the Castle district of Buda with Matthias Church and the Fishermen Bastion, on the Pest side will cross the Andrassy avenue to reach the Heroes Square, we shall see the Opera (exterior), the Vajdahunyad Castle, the Szechenyi baths and the Parliament (exterior).

In the afternoon excursion to Gödöllő to visit the summer palace of Sissi:

Visit the summer residence of the Austrian empress and Hungarian queen Sissi, the largest baroque palace of Hungary.

In the coffee shop we can taste one of her favorite cakes and take a coffee. Know her history, you will see her personal belongings and walk through the palace gardens to visit Royal Riding School.

Overnight in Budapest

Day 8. BUDAPEST

Breakfast at the hotel.

Free to leisure to enjoy the city or shopping

Night cruise on the Danube river in a boat chartered exclusively for the group, with explanations of the guide on the illuminated monuments along the river.

Free time until transfer to the airport.
